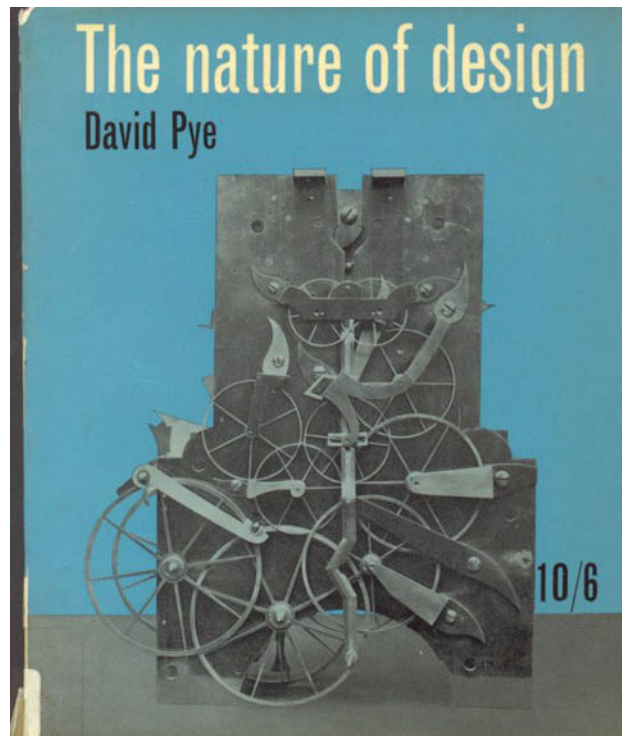

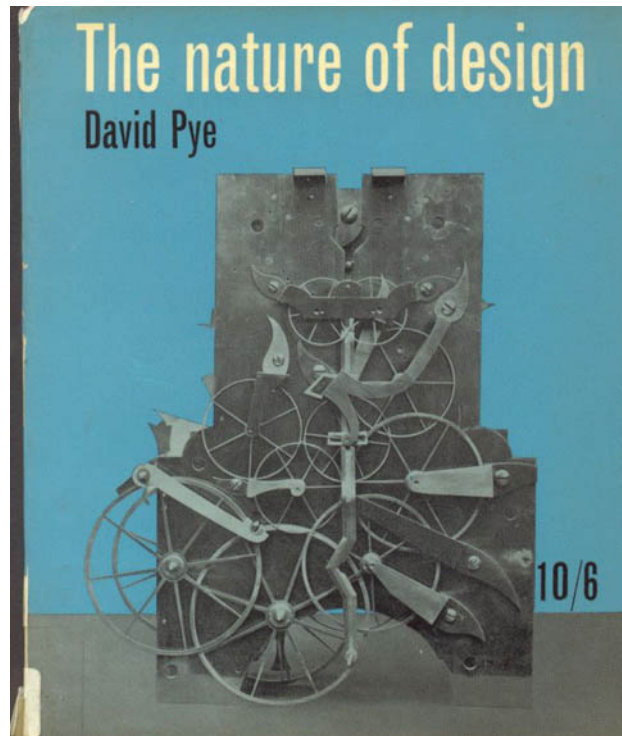
The Nature of Design 1964

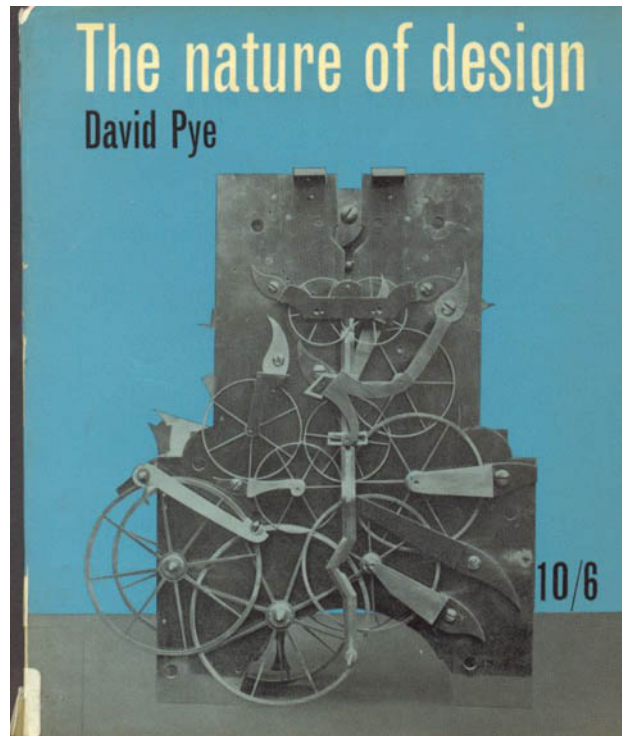


6 Requirements of Design:
